This national trend is also reflected in most major cities. in places like new york, san francisco and chicago, both the number of people in poverty and the global poverty rate has increased since 2005. find out now: is it better to rent or buy? There are some cities, however, which have hindered this national trend. In fact, the smartasset analysis of census bureau data found that not only poverty fell into a handful of United States cities, it fell. to reach this conclusion, smartasset has analyzed data over 370 of the largest metropolitan areas in the United States. We have taken a holistic approach, considering more poverty and poverty growth measures, the cities that emerged in our analysis are those in which both the poverty rate and the population living below the poverty threshold have descended substantially since 2005, even as (with themeasures) poverty has grown in the rest of the United States (read more about the methodology below) poverty is increasing in larger cities. the world10 years, only one of the 100 largest metropolitan areas in the United States has seen decline in both the number and the percentage of people living in poverty. On the other hand, 25 smaller metropolitan areas saw a decline in poverty on board. Texas Metros are the list. The first two subways where poverty is falling faster are both located in Texas. Of the 26 subways in which the poverty rate and the population in poverty have decreased, six are in Texas. But not California. Zero of the 26 metropolitan areas of California have seen the declines of the poverty rate in the last ten years. Poverty increases can also be aggravated by the increasing cost of housing and other living expenses in places like San Francisco and Los Angeles. Odessa, Texas The economy of Odessa has flourished over the last 10 years, driven by a strong growth in the energy sector of the region. At that time, the population of the Odessa metropolitan area grew from 133,000 to 153,000, an expansion of approximately 15%. The population living below the poverty line, however, fell by almost 40% in the same period. It's been from 14,000 to 15,000. In short, poverty in the Odessa area has fallen. While the subway poverty rate was well above the national average in 2005 to 19.6%, today is only 10%. This is well below the national average. Midland, TexasLocated 20 miles east of Odessa, Midland today has the third lowest poverty rate of any U.S. subway, just 7.8%. It wasn't always that low. In fact, in 2005 the poverty rate in Midland was 15.2% higher than the national average. The growing economy and the influx of new residents have helped to drastically reduce poverty in the region over the past 10 years. Cedar Rapids, Iowa The second largest city in Iowa, Cedar Rapids has a metropolitan population of263,000. This is an increase of 9% since 2005. Perhaps because of the reliable and low unemployment rate of the area, the number of people living in poverty in the area of Cedar Rapids has decreased more thanin the same period. This is good for a drop of 15.5%, among the highest in the United States. Jacksonville, North CarolinaJacksonville is located 20 miles from the Atlantic coast in North East Carolina, and is home to Camp Lejeune, a military base of 246 miles. It is also one of the fastest growing metropolitan areas in the country, with a total population increasing almost 50% since 2005. Moving to NC? Despite the explosion of the population, the house in the area remains relatively affordable, with a domestic value of only \$156,800. For those who live or below the poverty line, which could make a big difference. The poverty rate in Jacksonville Metro fell from 18.2% to 13.2% from 2005. California-Lexington Park, Maryland La California-Lexington The park's metropolitan area, which is coterminous with St. Mary County, Maryland, is located along the Chesapeake Bay south of Washington, D.C and Baltimore. After falling from 9% to 7.5% over the last ten years, the poverty rate in the California-Lexington Park subway is now the lowest in any U.S. subway area. Burlington, Vermont Located along the eastern shore of Lake Champlain in the northern Vermont, the Burlington area is the largest metropolitan area in the state. The city of Burlington is home to the University of Vermont, which is one of the largest employers in the area. Even when the total population of the Burlington subway has grown by over 18,000 inhabitants in the last ten years, the number of people living under the poverty line has fallen by 3,000. Greeley, Colorado The town of Greeley was originally founded in 1869 with the hope ofa utopian settlement, built on ideals such as temperance and commitment to the family. Since those early days, alcohol in the city has been legalized and the population has grown by 24% in the last decade alone. However, poverty in the arealow. The poverty rate in the Greeley metropolitan area is the lowest 20th among the most 370 metropolitan in the SmartAsset study at 9.8%. This represents an absolute decline of 2.1% since 2005. Midland, Michigan The number of people living below the poverty line in this central city of Michigan has fallen by almost 15% over the last ten years. Today there are less than 10,000 people in poverty in the Midland metropolitan area. This is equivalent to a poverty rate of just 11.7%. This is well below the national rate, which is 16.3%. Tuscaloosa, AlabamaTuscaloosa is home to the University of Alabama, which, with a student body of more than 37,000, is a key driver of the economy of the region. The manufacturing industry is also important, as the area houses a Mercedes Benz assembly plant and factories for a number of other major employers. The population of the metropolitan area grew from 189,000 in 2005 to about 236,000 today. However, the number of people living below the poverty line in the Tuscaloosa area has fallen over the last ten years by more than 3,000. Rapid City, South DakotaAs in August 2015, the unemployment rate in the Rapid City metropolitan area was just 3.6%, well below the national average. This is consistent with the long-term trend. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, unemployment in Rapid City was not more than 5.4% at any point during the last decade, even during the recession. This means that there are more people with work and less they are struggling to stay afloat. The poverty rate in Rapid City has decreased by 2.2% over the last ten years and today is just 11.9%, well below the national average. Methodology To find the metropolitan areas where poverty has fallen faster over the past ten years, SmartAsset has used a holistic approach, taking into account different measuresin poverty over the last 10 years. We wanted to find areas where poverty is falling rapidly – but not because it was beginning to a very high level. (For example, a city with an initial poverty rate50% could see poverty falling half and still have poverty rates well above the national average.) To this end, we considered the following four measures: the percentage change of the population living below the poverty line, the current poverty rate, the absolute change of the poverty rate and the relative change of the poverty rate. (If the poverty rate drops from 20% to 10%, absolute change is 10%, but relative change is 50% because it fell half). Using the U.S. Census Bureau data from 2005 and 2014, SmartAsset has calculated each of these four metrics for the largest 376 metropolitan areas in the United States. We have therefore determined how far above or below the national average each metropolitan area evaluated for each metric. We've totaled those deviations and ranked every meter accordingly.
